One in 36 of those diagnosed will lose their life. Early detection of breast cancer is critical. By getting your mammogram yearly, the chances of your cancer being fatal are significantly lower. Finding breast cancers early through mammography before symptoms occur decreases the risk that the cancer has spread outside the breast. Early detection truly is the best protection. According to American Cancer Society, women should have annual mammograms starting at age 40. All women should know their breasts and report any changes to their physicians as soon as possible.
